Thomas Munn was born in Northern Pennsylvania. After serving four years with the United States Navy, he attended Alfred Technical Institute. For the next thirty years, Tom worked in sales and marketing for several electronic companies.

He resided in West Palm Beach, Florida for forty years and began painting in 1975. He painted landscapes of the Northeast and the Florida landscape.
